Choosing the right colour

Choosing the colour for your roof, cladding or fencing is an important decision. Here are some tips to help you.

Three's the limit

Selecting colours for your roof, cladding or fencing is an important decision. A simple rule is to use no more than three colours: a field colour (the main colour, such as cladding or roof), an accent colour (for doors or shutters), and a trim colour (for joinery, gutters and downpipes). Accents can be bold, while trim colours should remain the same as, or complement, the field colour for a more cohesive look.

Your surroundings

Think about how your home sits in its environment. Lighter or brighter colours can help homes set back from the road or surrounded by trees stand out, while neutral colours often blend well with the landscape and create a welcoming feel. Different settings and architectural styles suit different colour palettes, so take cues from your location and neighbouring homes.

Work with what you have

When renovating, factor in existing elements like stonework, paths and driveways, and choose colours that complement the current palette.

Corrugate



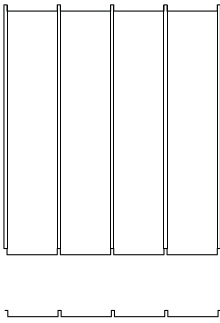

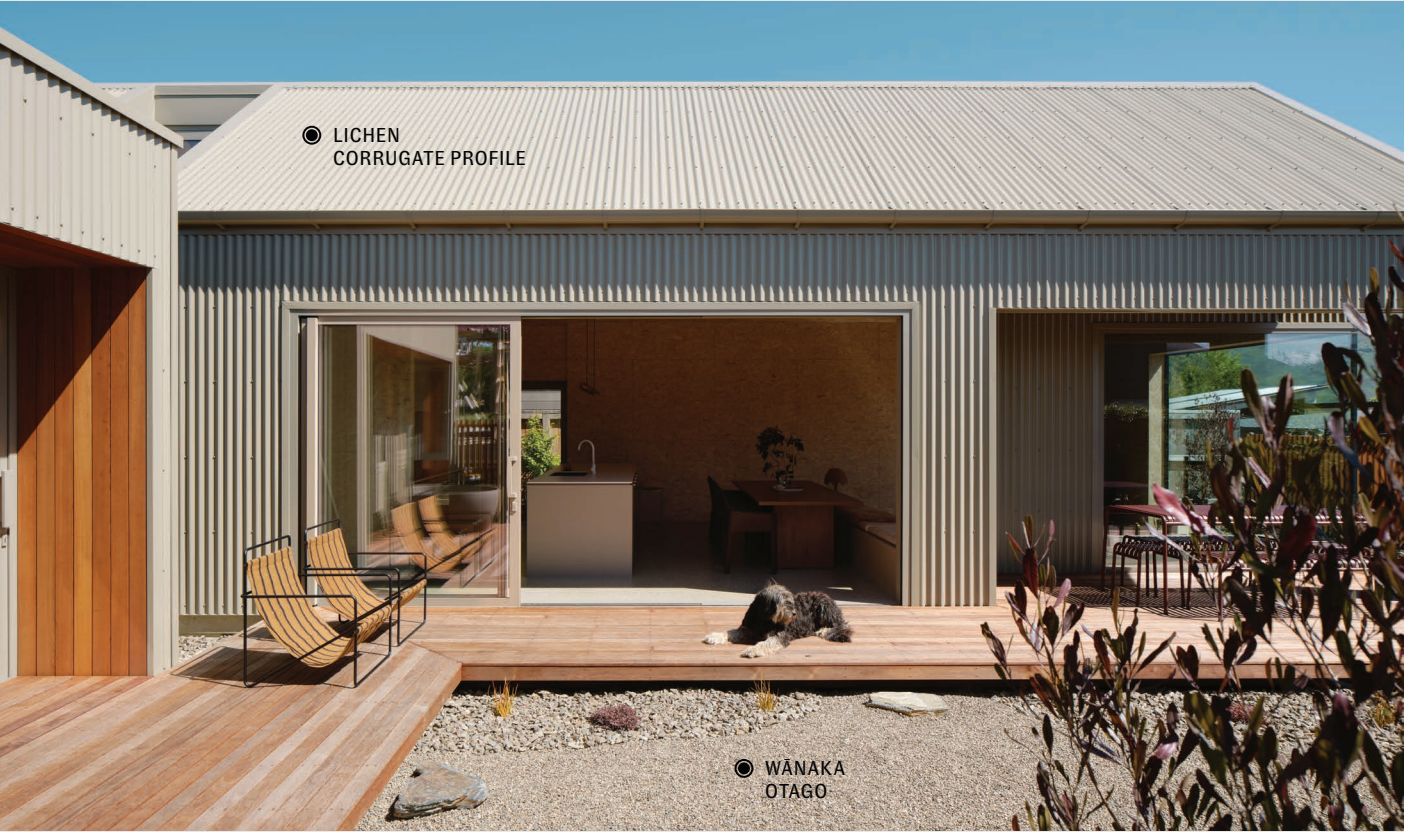

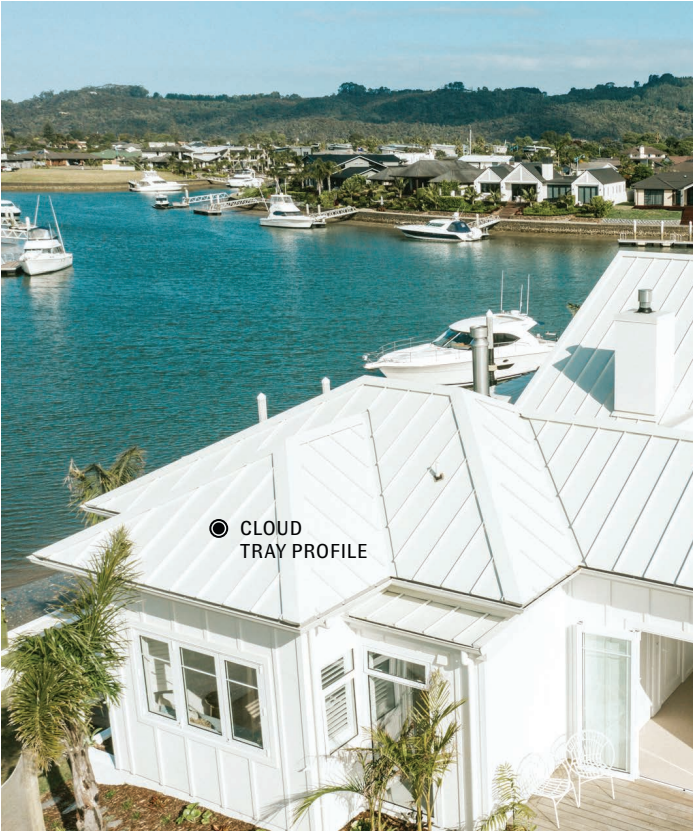
